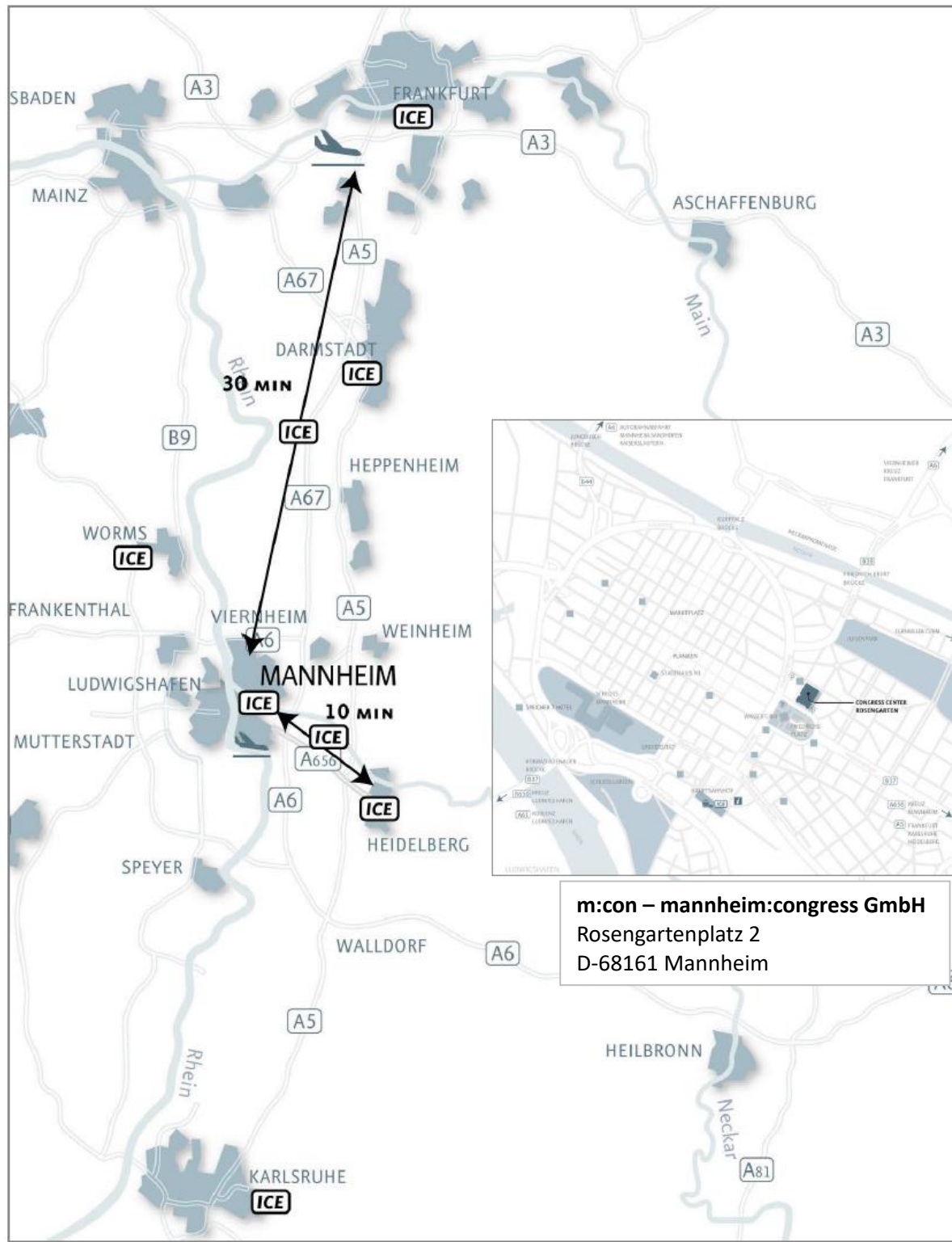
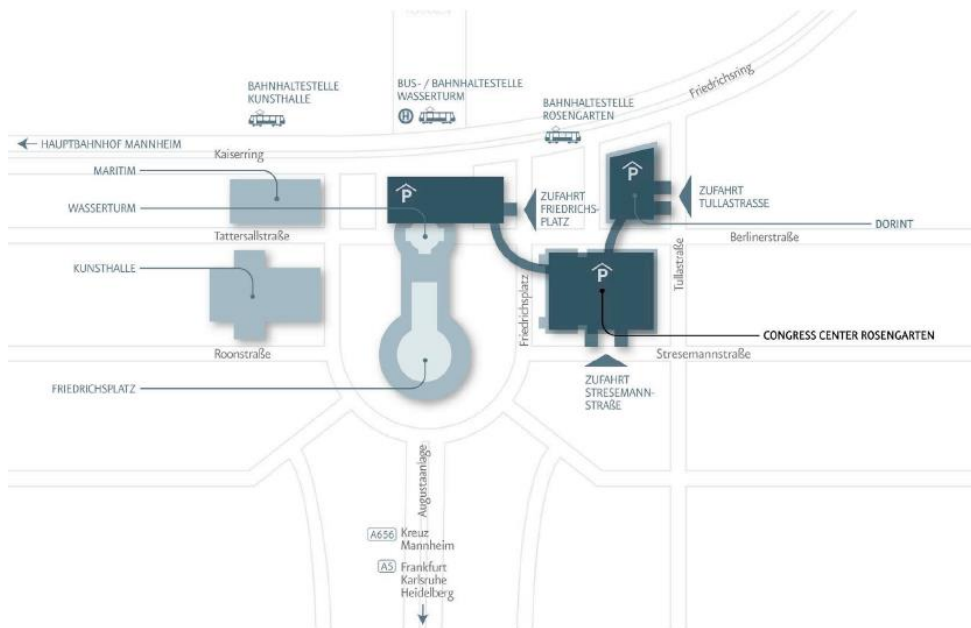


## How to get to the MWM Energy Days





### Arrival by car:

Coming to the Mannheim or Heidelberg interchange on the A6 or A5, take the A656 toward Mannheim-Mitte (past the Planetarium and the Landesmuseum für Technik und Arbeit, Augustaanlage, Friedrichsplatz, Wasserturm – CC Rosengarten). Plenty of parking spaces are available at the Congress Center Rosengarten and the adjacent Kunsthalle underground car park.

### Arrival by train, S-Bahn, bus:

Mannheim is an ICE/IC station. Direct ICE trains to Mannheim are available from Basel, Berlin, Düsseldorf, Frankfurt am Main, Frankfurt am Main Airport, Freiburg, Hamburg, Cologne, Munich, Paris, Stuttgart, and many other cities. From the railway station, you can reach Rosengarten on foot in 10 minutes (walking toward the city center).

#### Streetcar lines to Rosengarten:

Line 3 toward Sandhofen, "Wasserturm" stop

Line 4/4A toward Käfertal/Heddesheim, "Wasserturm" stop

Line 5 OEG toward Viernheim-Weinheim, "Rosengarten" stop

#### Bus lines to Rosengarten:

Line 60 toward Mannheim, Lanzvilla, "Wasserturm" stop

Line 63 toward Lindenhof, Pfalzplatz, "Wasserturm" stop

Line 64 toward Käfertal, OEG station, "Wasserturm" stop

### Arrival by plane:

Frankfurt Airport is directly connected to Mannheim via the ICE network (travel time 30 minutes). From the railway station, you can reach Rosengarten on foot in 10 minutes (walking toward the city center).

Rhein-Neckar Air offers up to two flights a day from Berlin to Mannheim and back. The short distances and free parking in Mannheim ensure a relaxed journey.
